
Enrolment Scheme Zone and Priorities

Applications for enrolment are now being accepted. and applications will be accepted in line with the priorities as given in the college's Ministerial Enrolment Scheme.

Currently the Enrolment scheme is still in a draft form. Given below are the 2 important aspects of of the draft scheme:

1. THE COLLEGE'S HOME ZONE

The geographical zone is outlined on the map below.



2. PRIORITIES FOR ACCEPTANCE

PRIORITY 1: Preference applicants living in the Home Zone and attending:

- Holy Trinity Catholic Primary School, Takanini
- St Mary's Catholic School, Papakura
- St Joseph's School, Pukekohe
- PRIORITY 2: Preference applicants living in the Home Zone, who are attending any other school

PRIORITY 3: Preference applicants not living in the Home Zone and attending:

- Holy Trinity Catholic Primary School, Takanini
- St Mary's Catholic School, Papakura
- St Joseph's School, Pukekohe

PRIORITY 4: Other preference applicants not living in the Home Zone

PRIORITY 5: Home Zone non-preference applicants attending:

- Holy Trinity Catholic Primary School, Takanini
- St Mary's Catholic School, Papakura
- St Joseph's School, Pukekohe

PRIORITY 6:In-zone non-preference applicants**NB**: Priorities 5 and 6 will apply only after all preference applicants have
been accepted.

Wait List Procedures

If the number of applicants is greater than the number of places available unsuccessful applicants will have their name recorded on the wait list within the relevant priority category, ranked against the priorities. Students on the waiting list may be offered places later if places become available. The waiting list will remain current until the beginning of the following school year.

Siblings at the same year level will be kept together for the purpose of the ballot, so that if one sibling's name is drawn, the other(s) is/are automatically successful also.

NOTES:

- Applicants seeking priority on the basis of sibling relationships may have to provide proof of this relationship
- Applicants seeking priority status on the basis of an Home Zone address will be required to provide proof of residency at this address and that the address has not been used as a temporary residency for the purpose of gaining entrance to the College
- The number of places available for non-preference students will be governed by the maximum allowable under the College's Integration Agreement
