# **Fair Play Charter**

St Ignatius of Loyola Catholic College is a fair play school.

### All participants aim to:

- Provide opportunities in a wide range of sports.
- Help students achieve personal success.
- Make sport enjoyable and rewarding.
- Foster self-esteem and respect for others.
- Compete with enthusiasm and fairness.
- Respect and abide by the sport's rules.
- Accept and respect officials' decisions.
- Respect teammates, opponents, and supporters.
- Value sportsmanship and accept victory or loss with dignity.

### **Player Code of Conduct**

### Players aim to:

- Play for fun, not just to please others.
- Play hard but by the rules.
- Show sportsmanship and respect for everyone.
- Attend all required activities.
- Notify the manager/coach of any unavailability one week prior.
- Stay committed to the team for the season.
- Wear appropriate team uniform.
- Respect equipment and facilities.
- Disclose any medical or physical conditions.
- Pay all sports fees on time.

#### Please note:





- (Premier Teams/Top Tier Teams) Students must maintain 95% attendance across the year
  in order to be eligible to attend Secondary School tournaments. Unless absence has been
  approved prior by the Sports Coordinator in conjunction with management and
  appropriate teaching staff, absence is for school related activity, or exceptional
  circumstances whereby the ultimate decision will lie with school management.
- Students who commit to school sport teams and then withdraw after the team has been named will become ineligible to represent the school in other sporting teams for the remainder of the year. Unless special circumstances have been approved by the Sports Coordinator in conjunction with management.
- Students must represent the school in school sport teams in order to be eligible to play
  for our regional school representative teams (Franklin Zone teams are excluded from this
  rule). Unless special circumstances have been approved by the Sports Coordinator in
  conjunction with management.
- Fees will be not reimbursed after registration with the sporting organisation has occurred.
   This includes if injuries are sustained during the season. Unless special circumstances have been approved by the Sports Coordinator in conjunction with management.

#### Coaches' Code of Conduct

#### Coaches aim to:

- Be generous with praise and set a good example.
- Be reasonable in demands on players' time and energy.
- Ensure all players get opportunities to play.
- Never ridicule a player for mistakes.
- Develop respect for referees' judgment.
- Follow medical advice for injured players.
- Insist on fair and disciplined play.





### Parent's Code of Conduct

# Parents aim to:

- Encourage children to play sports if interested.
- Focus on efforts and performance, not just outcomes.
- Encourage abiding by the rules.
- Never ridicule or shout at a child for mistakes.
- Remember sports are for children's enjoyment.
- Applaud good play by both teams.
- Address disagreements with officials through proper channels.
- Support volunteer coaches and the team's goals.
- Ensure comments from the sideline are positive.

# **Spectator's Code of Conduct**

# **Spectators aim to:**

- Remember children play for fun.
- Applaud good play by all teams.
- Show respect for opponents and referees.
- Never ridicule or scold a child for mistakes.
- Condemn violence and encourage rule-following.



# **Behaviour Management**

All participants have the right to a fun, safe, and healthy environment. Bad behaviour is not tolerated.

#### **Guidelines**:

- Coaches/managers can address minor breaches.
- Major breaches or harmful behaviour must be reported to the school immediately.

### Procedure:

- Address the offending student and inform them of the inappropriate behaviour.
- Notify parents to remove the student if necessary.
- Report the incident to the Sport Coordinator.
- The student's Manutaki will investigate the incident.
